Brady Singleton was a member of the Credit Union from the time he was born until his untimely death at the age of 3 years 9 months. He was killed in a drunken driving hit-and-run collision where 3 occupants of a truck drove off to leave Brady to drown in a creek. His savings account, which was for college, was used for his burial expenses instead.

Brady loved going to the Credit Union where he gave high-fives all around and the employees gave him his favorite suckers. He always asked for Brett Deal, the manager of the Credit Union, and was disappointed if he was not there at the time. Because he was treated so well, Brady asked his parents to stop at the Credit Union every time they drove past.
